PARTNERS' RIGHTS

- **ADVOCACY**

- Invitation to contribute and co-sign the numerous position papers, op-eds, articles, and other documents published by ACTE.

- **EVENTS**

- Invitation to all the events organized by the association, possibility of active participation of the partners. The participation of the partners in the association's events will always be free of charge.

- **CONSORTIUM**

- ACTE's members wish to work closely with their partners to develop EU projects and contribute to EU funding and tender opportunities.

- **VISIBILITY ON ACTE'S WEBSITE**

- To concretize the partnership with our association, the logo of each partner and the link to their website will be displayed on ACTE's website.

- **SPONSORSHIP**

- **Partners can sponsor events on a case by case relevance.**
